For the first time, Women scientists at Atomic Energy Research Establishment (AERE), the research hub of BAEC at Savar, Dhaka celebrated International Women's day on Sunday 8 March, 2020. A rally was organized by OWSD BD members together with common scientists in AERE campus. The colourful rally started at 10:30 am from Institute of Electronics and marched through Institute of Nuclear Science and Technology and ends at the premises of Institute of Food and Radiation Biology (IFRB), one of the pioneer institute at AERE.

IFRB hosted a seminar on the 'Generation Equality: How Women Scientists at AERE Contributing to Achieve the Goal' where five senior scientists have talked on their experience, barriers and achievements in carrying out different national and international projects. Around 40 women scientist participated in the seminar which continued from 11:30 am till 1:00 pm in presence of Director General, AERE, Dr Md Nurul Islam.

The seminar was co-ordinated by Dr Tabassum Mumtaz, who briefed on the history of IWD, its gradual development and how UN and UNESCO based organizations like OWSD has been working on the empowerment of women in through schemes like PhD fellowships, Early career research grants, awards etc. Director General, in his speech greeted the initiative and urged that these activities to be held regularly with bigger audience. He also acknowledged the support of OWSD and expressed his sincere gratitude towards Govt's policies in lifting up women of all walks of life in Bangladesh. The seminar was officially inaugurated by cutting cake with five speakers on stage with DG.

#### 1<sup>st</sup> speaker

Dr Mahfuza Khan, Director IFRB & Excom NC welcomed all and expressed her deep concern and commitment in helping young scientists for upgrading their career. She had successfully completed a no. of Co-ordinated research projects (CRP) under IAEA and is now planning to move forward to Technical co-operation projects (TC) to expand her research on fruitfly SIT.

### 2nd speaker

Dr Rokhsana Huque, Food Safety specialist and TC project leader on 'Food Traceability and Authentication' explained in details how a TC project can be submitted and implemented after approval. She also showed how collaborative works had helped her to achieve project milestones on time.

#### 3rd speaker

Dr Farzana Yesmin, OWSD alumni and recipient of TWAS grant began her research career at AERE as MSc student under CRP. After joining she got OWSD fellowship and pursued her phD at UKM, Malaysia and received FRGS grant. In 2016, after joining back BAEC, she won TWAS grant which has been extended recently. Her engagement with world experts on fruitfly cytogenetics had made her confident, knowledgeable and committed to carry on further research at her own workplace.

### 4<sup>th</sup> Speaker

Nuclear chemist Dr Salma Sultana, head of Nuclear and Radiation Chemistry division at INST had been working on FNCA project on Hydrogel and chitosan for past 5 years. She is an expert in radiation processing of polymeric materials and through her R & D activities, she wished to continue more cutting edge researches to meet future need. Her research team member Dr Nazia also received CRP recently.

#### 5<sup>th</sup> speaker

OWSD member Ms Fahmida Akter, Principal Engineer and head of Nuclear Electronics Division is also the project director of Govt funded ADP. The infrastructure renovation of her institute is taking place through her ADP project since its construction in early 1980s. She was officially taken this project on this same day in 2019 and from thenshe prepared herself to be fit for the task and gradually learnt basics of project management e.g., procurement of works and goods. She thanked her husband and family members for supporting her and helped her balancing work and home.





The interactive session stirred audience where a number of scientists expressed their views about IWD and paid gratitude to mothers whose sacrifice contributed a lot in their career. Ms Nuba thanked organizers to make such an extraordinary program and proposed to have health campaign for women in slum areas in Dhaka.
